Dear Parents/Carers

Children attending Camp School Nursery for 30 hours a week will be able to have School Dinners in the school dining room from 25th February 2019.

The meals are prepared and served by Hertfordshire Catering Ltd staff here on site in the school kitchen and attached is a copy of the rolling 3-week menu. The menu is revised during the year, and your children will be served lunch from Week 1 of the current menu when they come back after half term on 25th February.

You'll note that the menu for each day is coloured red, green or yellow. This is because red meals include meat, green meals are vegetarian and yellow meals are jacket potatoes served with beans or cheese.

If you would like your child to have a school lunch, we'd ask that you discuss the choices with them on the way to school and move their name onto the relevant coloured sheet on the wall.

The cost will be £2.30 per child as school meals are not provided free of charge by the Government before they join Reception Class. Payment can be made online via the School Gateway.

Please note that the kitchen is a nut free environment (hence our request that packed lunches are nut free too) and therefore the meals are safe for children affected by nut allergy. Herts Catering Ltd do however require registration online with medical evidence to ensure that a special menu is created for any child with particular dietary requirements.
