## Scooter Training

We are pleased to inform you that Year 1 and Year 2 children will be taking part in a scooter training session on **Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> April**. The sessions will be in school time and will be run by the Herts County Council Road Safety in Schools Team.

The children will be taught to ride their scooters safely on the school playgrounds. Each training session will run for approximately 30 minutes. Please ensure your child is dressed for the weather expected.

To participate in these sessions every child will need a scooter on the day. It is a good idea to name your child's scooter to avoid confusion.

Some children may need to borrow a scooter in order to take part in the sessions. If you have a spare scooter that you could lend to another child or if you are willing to lend your child's scooter to another child for a different session on the day then please let the class teacher know.

Please be aware of our schools rules with regards to scooting on site. Scooters should not be ridden once your child is inside the school gates.

Helmets are not essential, however if your child brings a helmet they will be asked to wear it for their session.

We are looking forward to this exciting learning opportunity and hope it will provide your child with the skills to ride their scooter safely on their journey to and from school.
