For Parents....

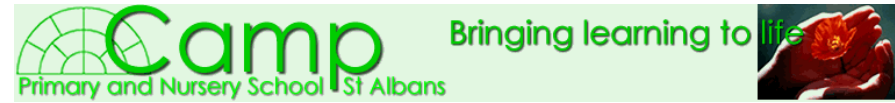

About The Club

Happy Campers After School Club aims to provide a happy, safe and stimulating environment for children after school. We hope to promote learning through play and activities whilst providing a fun and relaxing environment. As an After School Club catering for children aged 4-11 we are required to follow the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum. We base our activity plans on the six areas of learning within this curriculum. Further details can be found in our handbook for parents.

We are based in the community room and Reception class areas. This location allows easy access to the playground for outdoor activities and parent or guardian collections. The available spaces enable children to choose from a variety of different activities including outdoor sports and games, arts and crafts, and quieter activities. The club operates from Monday to Thursday term time only.

At the end of the school day children will be collected from their classrooms by a member of our staff.

As Camp Primary and Nursery School promotes healthy eating, we offer a choice of healthy and nutritious snacks. Low sugar drinks will be available, and we have use of a chilled drinking water station. If your child has any special dietary requirements please inform us when completing the registration forms.
