Dear Parents and Carers,

Our Science and Personal, Social and Health education (PSHE) curriculum coverage this half term will include Sex and Relationships Education (SRE), in all classes.

SRE is about physical, moral and emotional development and helps young people to understand the value and importance of respect, love, care, marriage and stable relationships.

Linked closely to the whole school PSHE themes of 'Changes' and 'Relationships' and our science topics in many year groups, SRE will be taught from the week commencing **Monday 17<sup>th</sup> June**. Lessons will be carried out in class and single sex groups where appropriate. We will use circle time, group work and discussion based on a scheme of work called 'The Christopher Winter Project', to support our SRE teaching and learning. An overview of the curriculum coverage for each year group and progression across the school is attached. The content covered will be carefully planned to ensure that it is taught in an age-appropriate and sensitive way. The children **do not watch a DVD** as part of this programme.

If you have any questions about SRE please make an appointment to speak with Rachel Rowe, Deputy Head or Ruth Rose, Assistant Head. To ensure there is enough time for a proper discussion please ensure you make an appointment to meet with these staff before 17<sup>th</sup> June, rather than trying to speak to your child's class teacher first thing in the morning before school.
