School Meal costs

In line with an increase from County, we need to increase the costs of school meals to £2.60 per day for pupils in KS2 from the start of the Summer Term. We will be continuing with our hot box lunch menu for the first half term and the children will continue to eat in classrooms before outside play. We ask that you stick to a regular meal pattern for each week and payments are made, via the School Gateway, in advance. Thank you.

Positive COVID-19 Case Reporting

All schools in Hertfordshire have been asked to continue supporting 'Track and Trace' procedures over the Easter Holidays. If your child tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) at any point during the Easter break, please notify us as soon as possible so we can complete the relevant tracking and tracing process with Public Health, if required, and notify any other children or staff who have been close contacts and who need to self-isolate. If your child has had a COVID test with a positive result, please inform us via

head@camp.herts.sch.uk so that we can co-ordinate information and inform any children or families if needed.

Please use COVID RESULT as the title of this email and include the following information:-

1. Name(s) of child(ren) who has tested positive
2. Contact phone number and email address
3. Date of onset of symptoms, (if any)
4. Description of symptoms
5. Date of positive test

We will pass this information on to Public Health England and will send out further instructions on isolation, testing, etc. to any families affected. Remember as soon as your child or any member of your household develops symptoms, they must start self-isolating immediately and book a test.

Please do not send children back to school in April if any of the following apply:

- they have symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19)
- they, any members of your household, or any close contacts (including extended family or friends they have seen) have tested positive for COVID-19
- they haven't completed the full 10 day isolation period requested

Thank you for your continued support and we hope that you do not need to contact us with any COVID-related information over the Easter break.
