Year 6 – Adventures and Activities Week – (a week of surprises!)

Dear parents and carers,

Before half term we shared with you some exciting plans we had for a special week of fun activities for our year six pupils to mark the end of their time at Camp School. We are now able to share with you some more detail of what this will look like. We have tried to take many of the aspects of our typical year six school journey trip that we know the children especially enjoy, whilst also utilising many areas of our own staff expertise to create a special week in school at a significantly reduced cost to you as parents and carers. **Adventures and Activities week (a week of surprises!) will take place from Monday 12th – Friday 16th July.** We want to keep this week really exciting for the children, and therefore they will take part in several surprise workshops and culminating in a special day trip to Vertigo Adventures at Stanborough Park on Friday 16th July. Here they will be able to complete the 'Hawks View High Ropes Course', 'The Crazy Climb' (climbing wall), and 'The Plummet'. Unless otherwise specified, please send your child in regular school uniform.

Monday, 12th July – Trainers, long sleeve top, joggers or leggings, a packed lunch and a cushion/blanket.

Tuesday, 13th July - Trainers and PE Kit

Wednesday, 14th July – Trainers, comfortable clothes that can get dirty, water pistol and bucket.

Thursday, 15^h July – Trainers, PE Kit, party clothes to change into.

Friday, 16th July - Trip to Vertigo Adventures - comfortable clothes suitable for the weather and ones you don't mind getting a little dirty. Ankle supporting boots or trainers (please do not wear sandals or open toe shoes) Long hair tied back, waists covered with no strappy tops. Piercings and jewellery must be removed. Packed Lunch and water bottle in a rucksack.

In order to reduce costs for this week of exciting activities, we would like to ask parents if they are able to provide transport to and from Stanborough Park. Please indicate on the form on the next page whether you are able to provide transport for your child and how many spaces you are able to offer for other children. It may be that we have a combination of different parents taking and collecting depending on availability. **We will need to leave school at 9:15 am** to allow us plenty of time to arrive at Vertigo Adventures by **9:45 am. We will need to be collected from Vertigo Adventures at 1:50 pm** to return to school in time for our usual 2:20 pm finish.

The total cost for this week of activities is £35.00 per child. **Payments and completed permission forms are to be made online by Friday 2nd July.** Please be aware that, should not enough parents contribute to the cost of the trip and the costs are not covered, the trip may have to be cancelled.
