All children are able to bring any offering, however we have divided the items out into suggested year groups so we don't have too many of the same items. Please can the children bring their donation items into school to add to the Harvest Collection Box in their classroom between the Monday 4<sup>th</sup> and Friday 15<sup>th</sup> of October.

Year Group	Suggested Donation
Nursery and Reception	Storable desserts and tinned rice pudding
Year One	Biscuits and spreads- honey, jam etc.
Year 2	Tinned vegetables and tinned soups
Year 3	Cereal (no oats) and long-life fruit juice
Year 4	Vermicelli, chickpeas and sunflower oil (one litre)
Year 5	Noodles, tinned spaghetti/baked beans
Year 6	Toilet roll, shampoo, laundry powder

The Foodbank have requested that they do not receive any pasta as they have plenty. Also no fresh foods or drinks please as they are unable to store them. Please make sure all donations have a good shelf life left on them.

We thank you in advance for your generous donations and co-operation.
