Dear Parents and Carers,

Parent Consultation sessions

We will be holding parent consultation evenings this term for all year groups in the week commencing 18th October 2021.

For our last consultations we used a system called SchoolCloud to both book the appointments and hold the consultations through a video system. The feedback from parents was very positive – the sessions ran on time so there was no waiting around in school for appointments and you didn't need to either organise a babysitter or bring the children out in the evening. We have decided therefore to continue consultations using this system for this academic year.

I must remind parents though that the system does automatically cut off the call at the end of 10 minutes which I am sure you will understand. A clock provides a countdown so you can see how long you have left which makes for a very purposeful use of the time.

These meetings are an important opportunity for us to discuss how your child has settled into school this term. We strongly recommend that all parents/carers make an appointment.

The appointment days and times will vary across year groups although all teachers will be offering the majority of slots on the afternoon/evening of **Wednesday 20th October** and the afternoon of **Thursday 21st October**. You will be able to see all available slots when you log on to book.

For those classes where there are two teachers, you will 'meet' with one of the teachers but the information and feedback will have been provided by both teachers.

The system will open for parents to book their appointment slots on **Monday 11th October from 6:00 pm**.
