Linked to our Ancient Greek topic this term, we are planning to have an 'Ancient Greek Day' on Wednesday 10th November. As part of the day, we plan to taste some traditional Greek foods, create some Greek art and continue to learn about Greek history and how it has influenced our lives.

It would be great if your child could dress up as any Ancient Greek Character, either as a citizen of Athens or a warrior from Sparta, but please do not spend money on an outfit unless you really want to do so. Instead, you can fold a plain bedsheet in half width wise and then length wise to make a chiton, the everyday outfit for ancient Greek men and women. Wrap the bedsheet around the child and connect the back and the front in place at each shoulder using safety pins. Tie a rope or belt around the waist and team with a pair of sandals for added authenticity.
